JOURNEY INTO AN ANCIENT CIVILIZATION: Reverend Leo Booth is about to take a group on this powerful journey retreat to **Teotihuacan and Mexico City**. Our group will experience this journey by staying at the beautiful Dreaming House.

During the time we experience this ancient and colorful culture in Mexico, we learn the steps to heal old wounds and interconnect with our inner spirit. Healing, nurturing our soul, and personal recovery will be our constant theme, so adequate time will be arranged for rest, seminars and relaxing conversations. As with all retreats, there will be time for us to journey into our personal silence and stillness.

DAY 1:
Meet the group at the Mexico City Airport in the Freedom Café (just outside customs). Pick up is at 4:00pm. Today we settle in at the lovely Dreaming House for dinner and a restful night.

DAY 2-5:
We spend the next four days exploring and moving throughout this incredible site. We spend time working in a group and individually. We will work through the energetic body of Teo, which follows the original design as the body of a two-headed serpent, the body of the avatar Quetzalcoatl.

From the **temple of Quetzalcoatl** we move into the Avenue of the Dead traveling toward the **Pyramid of the Moon**. As we ascend over the days of our journey, you will address the energetic aspects of being human from the physical body of the emotions, the mind and the spirit. We address each as they are portrayed through the elements of earth, air, fire and water. The journey through the body of Teo leads to a reemergence from the deep introspection of the Avenue through the other mouth of the snake on the altar in front of the Pyramid of the Moon.

The next step is to join the presence and timeless power of the ancient masters in the **temple of the Jaguars and the Palace of the Butterflies** preparing us for our reconnection with the source atop the **Pyramid of the Sun**. A journey to **Teotihuacan** is an opening to worlds that for most of us have been shrouded by our investment in what we have come to believe of this world and ourselves.

DAY 6:
Free day – during the day, you may plan your own activities, or just rest and relax. In the evening, experience traditional **Aztec dancers**.

DAY 7:
We take a day-trip into Mexico City. We will have a visit to this memorial museum which is called **Frida Kahlo House**, Frida Kahlo was a well known artist in Mexico during the 40's.

DAY 8:
Day of the Dead celebration – a very cultural and colorful day, this is one of the very important celebrations in Mexico culture. Our group will spend time building an altar and doing a ceremony to honor the dead.

DAY 9:
Free day – during the day, you may plan your own activities, or just relax with self-reflection in this sacred land. Group farewell dinner celebrated by **live Mariachis music**.

DAY 10:
Group is heading home. This morning we will arrive into the heart of Mexico City and visit **The Cathedral of Our Lady of Guadalupe** and then off to the Airport for our departure flights after 4:00pm.
